YOUTH PARTICIPANT CONFIDENTIALITY, NON-DISCLOSURE, INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, PRIVACY AND PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT AGREEMENT

FOR PARTICIPANTS AGES 13 THROUGH 18. FOR A PARTICIPANT UNDER 18, A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST REVIEW AND ACCEPT THIS AGREEMENT, AND THE MINOR MUST PROVIDE SEPARATE ASSENT. A PARTICIPANT WHO IS 18 MAY ACCEPT AND SIGN INDEPENDENTLY.

This Youth Participant Confidentiality, Non-Disclosure, Intellectual Property, Privacy and Parent/Guardian Consent Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into among Team Thrive LLC, a New York limited liability company ("Team Thrive"), the minor participant identified in the online acceptance record or signature block (the "Minor"), and the Minor's parent or legal guardian (the "Parent/Guardian"). The Agreement is effective when the Parent/Guardian completes the required electronic-consent process or signs below (the "Effective Date"). For purposes of this Agreement, "Minor" means a participant under 18; a participant who is 18 signs personally and no parent/guardian consent is required.

1. PURPOSE

The Minor may participate in beta testing, product demonstrations, app development, user research, advisory activities, training, events, team or club activities, communications, surveys, interviews, or other authorized activities involving Team Thrive (collectively, the "Activities"). This Agreement is intended to protect Team Thrive's confidential information, technology, business interests, intellectual property, users, and systems while also protecting the Minor's privacy, safety, personal information, legal rights, and ability to seek help or report concerns.

2. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

"Confidential Information" means all non-public information disclosed, displayed, observed, accessed, received, or learned through Team Thrive, in any form. It includes, without limitation: source code, object code, APIs, algorithms, artificial-intelligence features, prompts and outputs; product plans, prototypes, designs, screens, workflows, road maps, unreleased features, bugs and testing materials; security methods, credentials, links and access codes; technical specifications and documentation; pricing, budgets, financial information, business plans, fundraising materials, investor information, marketing strategies, partnerships, vendors, customers, clubs and prospects; and non-public information concerning athletes, minors, parents, coaches, teams, clubs, employees, contractors, or other users. Confidential Information also includes screenshots, recordings, notes, summaries, analyses, copies, and materials derived from such information.

Confidential Information does not include information that the receiving party can prove: (a) became public without breach of this Agreement; (b) was lawfully known without restriction before disclosure; (c) was lawfully obtained from a third party without a confidentiality duty; or (d) was independently developed without use of Team Thrive Confidential Information.

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE MINOR AND PARENT/GUARDIAN

The Minor and Parent/Guardian shall: (a) keep Confidential Information strictly confidential; (b) use it only for the Activities and only as authorized by Team Thrive; (c) not disclose it to friends, classmates, teammates, coaches, social-media followers, online groups, competitors, media, or any unauthorized person; (d) not photograph, screenshot, screen-record, livestream, copy, download, upload, post, publish, transmit, sell, license, scrape, extract, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise exploit it; (e) not upload it to any external artificial-intelligence system, chatbot, cloud drive, file-sharing service, or third-party software without written authorization; (f) protect all passwords, devices, test accounts, links, and credentials; (g) not use Confidential Information to build, assist, or advise a competing product or service; and (h) promptly notify Team Thrive and the Parent/Guardian of any loss, mistaken disclosure, unauthorized access, security concern, or suspected breach.

4. CHILD-SAFETY AND PROTECTED-REPORTING EXCEPTION

Nothing in this Agreement prohibits or discourages the Minor or Parent/Guardian from seeking medical care, legal advice, counseling, or emergency help, or from reporting suspected abuse, harassment, bullying, threats, exploitation, discrimination, unsafe conduct, privacy concerns, security incidents, or unlawful activity to a parent or guardian, school official, coach, attorney, doctor, counselor, law-enforcement agency, regulator, child-protection authority, or other appropriate person or authority. No confidentiality obligation applies to the extent a disclosure is legally protected or required by law. Team Thrive will not retaliate against a Minor for making a good-faith safety report or seeking help.

5. PROTECTION OF THE MINOR'S PRIVACY AND PERSONAL INFORMATION

Team Thrive shall handle personal information concerning the Minor in accordance with its then-current Privacy Policy, Terms of Use, parental-consent process, and applicable law. This Agreement does not waive any non-waivable privacy, consumer-protection, child-safety, or statutory rights. Team Thrive shall use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards appropriate to the nature of the information. Team Thrive will not knowingly sell the Minor's personal information or use the Minor's name, image, voice, likeness, biography, performance footage, or personal story for advertising, publicity, endorsement, or promotional purposes unless the Parent/Guardian provides separate, clear consent where required by law.

Team Thrive may suspend or terminate access when reasonably necessary to protect the Minor, other users, confidential information, systems, or legal compliance. The Parent/Guardian may contact Team Thrive to request access, correction, deletion, or other available privacy rights regarding the Minor's information, subject to applicable law and legitimate retention obligations.

6. OWNERSHIP AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

All Team Thrive software, technology, content, brands, trademarks, designs, interfaces, documentation, data structures, concepts, inventions, improvements, and other intellectual property remain exclusively owned by Team Thrive or its licensors. No ownership interest is transferred. The Minor receives only a limited, personal, revocable, non-transferable right to participate in authorized Activities.

For voluntary feedback, ideas, suggestions, comments, bug reports, feature requests, test results, or other input specifically about Team Thrive ("Feedback"), the Parent/Guardian grants, personally and to the fullest extent legally permitted on behalf of the Minor, a worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable, transferable, sublicensable, royalty-free right for Team Thrive to use and commercialize the Feedback without payment or attribution. This clause does not transfer ownership of the Minor's pre-existing personal content or grant publicity rights.

7. RETURN, DELETION AND TERMINATION

Upon Team Thrive's request or the end of the Activities, the Minor and Parent/Guardian shall stop using Confidential Information, return or permanently delete all copies under their control, and remove access credentials. Team Thrive may request written certification of deletion. Team Thrive may suspend or terminate access immediately for security, privacy, safety, legal, or confidentiality reasons.

8. TERM AND SURVIVAL

The Agreement begins on the Effective Date and continues during the Activities. Trade-secret obligations continue for as long as the information remains a trade secret under applicable law. Obligations for other Confidential Information continue for five (5) years after the later of the last disclosure or the end of the Activities. Ownership, Feedback, privacy, remedies, governing law, and accrued rights survive termination.

9. BREACH AND REMEDIES

Unauthorized use or disclosure may cause serious harm that may be difficult to measure. Subject to applicable law and the rights of minors, Team Thrive may seek appropriate injunctive or equitable relief and other lawful remedies. Any response involving a Minor should be proportionate and should consider the Minor's age, intent, circumstances, safety, and whether the conduct was accidental. Nothing in this Agreement imposes automatic punitive damages, waives a non-waivable right, or makes the Parent/Guardian automatically liable for conduct beyond what applicable law permits.

10. PARENT/GUARDIAN AUTHORITY AND CONSENT

The Parent/Guardian represents that they are the Minor's parent or duly authorized legal guardian, have authority to provide consent, have reviewed this Agreement with the Minor in age-appropriate language, consent to the Minor's participation, agree to supervise and reasonably assist compliance, and agree to be personally bound with respect to their own access, use, disclosure, acts, and omissions.

11. MINOR'S ASSENT

The Minor acknowledges: "I have read this Agreement, or it has been explained to me in a way I understand. I agree to keep Team Thrive's private information private, protect other users' information, use Team Thrive only as permitted, and tell my Parent/Guardian or Team Thrive if I see a safety, privacy, or security problem. I understand that I may always seek help and report unsafe or unlawful conduct."

12. GOVERNING LAW; VENUE; SEVERABILITY

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of New York, without regard to conflict-of-law principles, except where another jurisdiction's mandatory law must apply to protect the Minor. Any court proceeding shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in New York County, New York, unless applicable law requires otherwise. If any provision is unenforceable, it shall be narrowed only to the minimum extent necessary, and the remaining provisions shall remain effective.

13. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; ELECTRONIC RECORDS

This Agreement, together with any applicable Privacy Policy, Terms of Use, parental-consent notice, or separate release, constitutes the agreement concerning its subject matter. Any amendment must be in writing or presented through a legally valid electronic update accepted by the Parent/Guardian. Electronic signatures, typed names, checked boxes, timestamps, audit logs, and electronic records may be used to the extent permitted by law. Team Thrive shall provide or make available a copy of the accepted Agreement to the Parent/Guardian.

14. REQUIRED ONLINE ACCEPTANCE AND CHECKBOXES

The website or app must not permit participation until all required fields are completed. The boxes below must be unchecked by default and affirmatively selected. Team Thrive should retain the exact Agreement version, date and time, IP address or equivalent audit data where lawful, account identifier, Parent/Guardian contact information, and the electronic-signature record.

☐ MINOR ASSENT: I am the Minor identified in this form. I have read this Agreement or had it explained to me, I understand it, and I agree to follow it.

☐ MINOR SAFETY ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I understand that I may always tell a trusted adult, seek help, or report unsafe or unlawful conduct.

☐ PARENT/GUARDIAN AUTHORITY: I certify that I am the Minor's parent or legally authorized guardian and have authority to consent.

☐ PARENT/GUARDIAN REVIEW: I have read this Agreement, reviewed it with the Minor in age-appropriate language, and had an opportunity to ask questions or seek legal advice.

☐ PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT: I consent to the Minor's participation and agree to the Parent/Guardian obligations in this Agreement.

☐ PRIVACY ACKNOWLEDGMENT: I acknowledge that I have received or can access Team Thrive's Privacy Policy and understand how to contact Team Thrive regarding the Minor's information.

☐ ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE: By typing my full legal name and selecting this box, I intend to sign this Agreement electronically and agree that my electronic signature has the same effect as my handwritten signature.

☐ COPY OF AGREEMENT: I understand that I may download, print, or receive a copy of the Agreement accepted online.
